What This workshop is especially for those have awareness and concern around the hydrocarbon twins - peak oil and climate change - and want to create a practical framework for "descending the energy mountain gracefully and ethically". Come with others from your area!

Where Wild Mountains is located in the spectacular Border Ranges of SEQ above Rathdowney. It has exhilarating views through windows in the forest across valleys to Mt Lindesay and Mt Barney and the folds of Main Range. Daytime temperatures are usually 5-10 ° cooler than Brisbane.

When Arrive at 8.30 am **Saturday 2 August**, depart at 4 pm **Sunday 3 August**. Wild Mountains is 40 minutes from Boonah or Beaudesert and a further hour from Brisbane or the Gold Coast. It is one hour from Kyogle via the Lions Rd. Directions will be sent on registration.

Facilitators Janet Millington and Sonya Wallace, founders and co-ordinators of Transition Sunshine Coast and the Sunshine Coast Energy Action Centre. [www.seac.net.au] have on-the-ground experience to share. Transition Sunshine Coast was Australia's first Transition Initiative and the first initiative outside the UK.

Accommodation is in dormitory camping cabins, with sleeping mats, or BYO tent. Recently-built showers and toilets, great vegetarian food. You bring WARM sleeping gear, WARM layers (beanie and scarf are great value and thermal underwear is not unknown!), rain jacket, slip-on footwear for indoors.
